General Description

Years ago the Owners took their leave of Canada with their young son, dog and cat and spent the next couple of years making their way down to Mexico, through the Marquesas and Tahiti before they finally ended up in the Bay of Islands. They set up home there for a decade so that their son could go back to school. Now it is time to move on pass on their lovely ketch to another adventurous owner as they have moved back to Canada.

This beautiful Offshore Ketch was built in South Africa in 1980. She is a spacious and comfortable passage maker. Strongly constructed with a 7mm Corten Stee Hull and 5mm deck she has a displacement of 29mt approx. Owners have been living on the boat periodically during their annual visits to New Zealand. She has only been lightly used over the last few years and is in excellent walk on - sail away condition. The yacht sleeps four to six persons with a comfortable master cabin forward. She is ideally set up for offshore or coastal cruising. She is powered by a 120hp Ford Lehman 2715E diesel and cruises at 6.0knots. The extensive electronics package includes B&G Autopilot with remote control on 25ft tether, B&G instruments with Gyro compass, Raytheon radar, Garmin GPS with backups, Icom M802 ssb radio, Icom M504 vhf radio with cockpit remote & dodger mounted hailer and Brookhouse multiplexer. This vessel is a must view. A marina berth is also available by arrangement.
